

About Our Programs

The NEBC's focus on applied learning is building strong connections between our schools and the world around us. Read more about the programs listed below—and how you can be a part of them—in our Annual Report, available online at www.the-nebc.org.

Partnership Grants

A year-long grant program that pairs educators with local business partners to provide authentic experiences in and outside the classroom.

Career Expo / Career Exploration Fair

NHS students attend presentations and exhibits by local businesses to learn about career choices.

Internships

Students receive hands-on learning experience and course credit for working in local businesses.

Job Shadow Day

High school freshmen spend the day with a local business person and report back to the class about the experience.

Externships

Teachers spend time in a business or industry and design lesson plans based on the experience.

Jazz Festival

Organized by NHS students, this annual community crowd pleaser showcases musical presentations by high school jazz bands in our area.

Book Bag

Elementary students learn to love reading with these thematic take-home bags of books, each decorated with artwork related to the contents and the logo of a business sponsor.

Port Day

Elementary school students learn about a variety of careers through presentations and demonstrations made by community and business leaders.

Entrepreneurship

High school students earn high school and college credit as they learn how to start a business and work with a business mentor in this new course underwritten by the NEBC.

Financial Planning

NEBC members from the financial planning industry secure textbooks for and assist high school instructors in adding a financial planning component to the wellness curriculum.
